The Lake Lothing is situated at the bottom end of Rotterdam Road, next to the roundabout at the junctions of Rotterdam Road, Denmark Road and Peto Way.

On Sunday nights from 7pm - midnight a weekly karaoke is available for all to participate in or just enjoy others making the entertainment. Our function room is available to hire free of charge for all occasions.
